Navigating the Deluge: Understanding and Addressing the Current Flood Crisis in Somalia

Summary

Somalia faces recurrent climate-related challenges, including droughts and floods. Over the past three decades, the frequency of flash floods and riverine floods has risen, disrupting livelihoods and the economy. Vulnerable Somali communities experience severe consequences across sectors, including livestock and crop-based livelihoods, housing, infrastructure, social services, and agriculture. This led to displacement, food insecurity, and reduced income, exacerbating a fragile humanitarian situation.

In the El Nino floods in 2023, there are significant impacts on food security, infrastructure, and basic services. There are Urgent government actions, but challenges such as insufficient logistical capacity, hard-to-reach areas, and coordination issues persist. Adequate resources are lacking to respond effectively to the ongoing disaster.

For a long-term solution, it is necessary to use an anticipatory approach, investing in infrastructure, building resilience, and fostering a robust humanitarian-development nexus to address the current crisis and future challenges.

**Fostering Somali Studies
at the Somali Universities**

Summary

Knowledge production and scholarly publications in social science were limited in Somalia until its collapse in 1991, mainly due to the establishment of Somali University lately in 1971. During the military rule (1969-1991), academic freedom was lacking, and social science studies at the Somali National University were marginalized. In recent years, Somali studies have evidently gained momentum, as seen in numerous conferences, academic journals, translations into the Somali language, and the publication of books.

Emphasizing Somali studies, including Somali history, society, Islam, and the Somali language, is crucial for all Somali universities to contribute to the cultural revival of the Somali people. Universities play a pivotal role in shaping a nation's intellectual landscape, fostering knowledge dissemination, critical thinking, and societal progress.

Somali scholars face the challenge of reconciling the modern state, clannish society, and Islam to establish a stable Somali state. Overcoming distorted views on the state, clans, Somaliness, and Islam is essential for meaningful change in actions and the transformation of political culture. Failure to address these issues may perpetuate the cycle of state failure.

The Nexus between Economic Growth, Corruption and Public–Debt: Empirical Evidence from Somalia

Abstract

This study investigates the causal relationship between corruption, debt, and economic growth in Somalia during 2005-2021. The study applied the autoregressive distributed lag (ARDL) approach to examine the impacts of corruption and debt on economic growth in Somalia. The ARDL-bound tests’ cointegration results indicate a long-run relationship between economic growth and other variables, including corruption, FDI gross fixed capital formation, and debt.

The finding also shows the negative and insignificant relationship between corruption, debt, and GDP growth; the increase in corruption and debt significantly impacts GDP growth, which means that increased corruption and debt lead to a decrease in GDP growth. Moreover, foreign direct investment and gross fixed capital formation have a positive relationship with economic growth, but FDI is significant, while Gross fixed capital formation is insignificant.

Recommendations of this research include building up strong institutions, enforcing anti-corruption Laws and promoting transparency and Accountability.

Meta-Analyses of Fraud and Financial Performance in Public Sector: Public Trust as Mediating Factor, Mogadishu, Somalia

Abstract

The study aims to investigate the impact of bribery on financial performance, identify the impact of corruption on financial performance, and determine the effect of Misuse of Authority on financial performance.

The study used meta-analysis, a systematic review of a focused topic in the literature that provides either a quantitative or a qualitative estimate for the effect of a treatment intervention or exposure with a homogenous body of existing literature.

The study finds that fraud is considered a significant problem within the public sector and negatively impacts the public sector's financial performance. The study concludes that increased forensic accountant investigation skills will result in higher fraud detection. The study recommends that forensic accounting be used for fraud detection in the public sector.

Abstract

The main objective of this study is to examine the integration of Management Information Systems to enhance decision-making in Somalia's commercial banking industry. MIS empowers managers with comprehensive insights, fostering informed decision-making, detailed operational analysis, and facilitating communication and planning.

Findings from interviews, questionnaires, and document reviews indicate commercial banks recognize the multifaceted benefits of MIS. Maximal economic advantages are acknowledged in crucial areas such as procurement management, production control, capital budgeting, and investment decisions. However, challenges persist, including a lack of an MIS integration policy and a scarcity of local educational faculties specializing in MIS.

The study recommends aligning organizational policies with evolving system requirements, bridging the skills gap through collaboration with academic institutions, and promoting the establishment of R&D sections within commercial banks to enhance innovation and adaptability. It concludes by advocating for further research in this field.

Technical and Vocational Education and Training in Somalia: Why and How to Revitalize

Abstract

The focus on general education in Somalia has created a gap between education, learners' needs, and market demand, leading to high unemployment rates. Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) is crucial, aligning skills with job market needs, contributing to national development, and addressing poverty and security. This study explores the current state of the TVET sector, analyzes its challenges, and proposes potential solutions to revive it. A qualitative research design was employed.

The study identified significant shortcomings in TVET, such as the absence of governance, exclusion from national education priorities, severe financial constraints, and non-formal vocational programs offering only basic level. Overcoming these challenges requires substantial improvements and strategic interventions.

The study proposes comprehensive recommendations to revitalize the TVET sector. These include establishing formal TVET programs, making TVET a national priority, and strengthening stakeholder collaboration. Additionally, political commitment at the highest government level is deemed essential, along with efforts to incentivize industrialization and ensure affordable electricity for economic development.

By examining the dynamics of public-private collaborations in Somali education, this study aims to provide insights into the challenges, opportunities, and implications of managing basic education through public-private partnerships in the Somali context.

Exploring Factors Influencing Undergraduate Students' Stress at Private Universities in Mogadishu-Somalia**Abstract**

This study aimed to determine and explore the factors influencing stress levels among undergraduate students attending private universities in Mogadishu, Somalia. The survey was conducted using a questionnaire distributed to students across various faculties of private universities.

A total of 1387 students were randomly selected to participate in the study. Critical analysis was carried out using descriptive analysis on the mean and standard deviations of the items and ANOVA in SPSS to test hypotheses pre-stated by the researcher and determine the variance among respondents.

The study found that personal and security factors significantly contributed to students' stress levels. Additionally, the study investigated assumptions related to gender, age, and year and found no statistically significant differences in students' perceptions of these characteristics.

Firstly, it seeks to assess the impact of teacher digital literacy on student performance; secondly, to identify the specific digital competencies influencing student outcomes; thirdly, it explores the mediating role of digital resources and school infrastructure in connecting teacher digital literacy to student performance. Additionally, it investigates challenges faced by teachers in developing digital literacy skills.

The findings of this study will contribute to the existing body of knowledge on the relationship between teacher digital literacy and student performance. The study proposes strategies to enhance teacher digital literacy and, consequently, improve student performance.

It is broadly divided into Cultural Heritage and Natural Heritage, with Cultural Heritage further classified as Tangible and Intangible Heritage. These categories collectively represent the essence of a society's identity and legacy, bridging the past and the future through tangible and intangible cultural elements and the preservation of the natural environment.

Somalia, located in the Horn of Africa, is a biodiversity hotspot with rich flora and fauna. Regrettably, the nation has experienced a significant loss in larger animal populations.

This study explores threats to Somalia's natural heritage, delving into the existing policies and regulations, including the Fauna (hunting) and forest conservation laws enacted by the government. The paper also highlights relevant articles in the Constitution of Somalia.

Moon-Spica Conjunction in Somali Traditional Time Reckoning
(Kulanka Dayaxa iyo Xiddigga Dirirka iyo Ammintirsiga Soomaalidii Hore)

Abstract

This study describes the role of the Moon-Spica conjunction in traditional Somali Time Reckoning, particularly emphasising the ‘gu’ season or spring season—the predominant rainy season in the Somali Peninsula. Within the spring season, distinct subseasons emerge, distinguished by varying climatic patterns, notably differences in precipitation levels. These variations significantly impact the essential seasonal activities of the society.

Similar to other communities, Somali people used traditional methods and observations over the centuries for timekeeping and recognising the seasons. Some methods were based on celestial events, known as ‘folk astronomy’. In this regard, the celestial event of Moon-Spica conjunctions, known as ‘dirirayn’ in the Somali language, is a crucial reference point for distinguishing these subseasons.

By exploring the Moon-Spica conjunctions, this research unveils the nuanced methods employed in Somali time reckoning. It is also a celestial reference point seamlessly integrated into the traditional Somali calendar, known as the ‘godtirsi’ system.

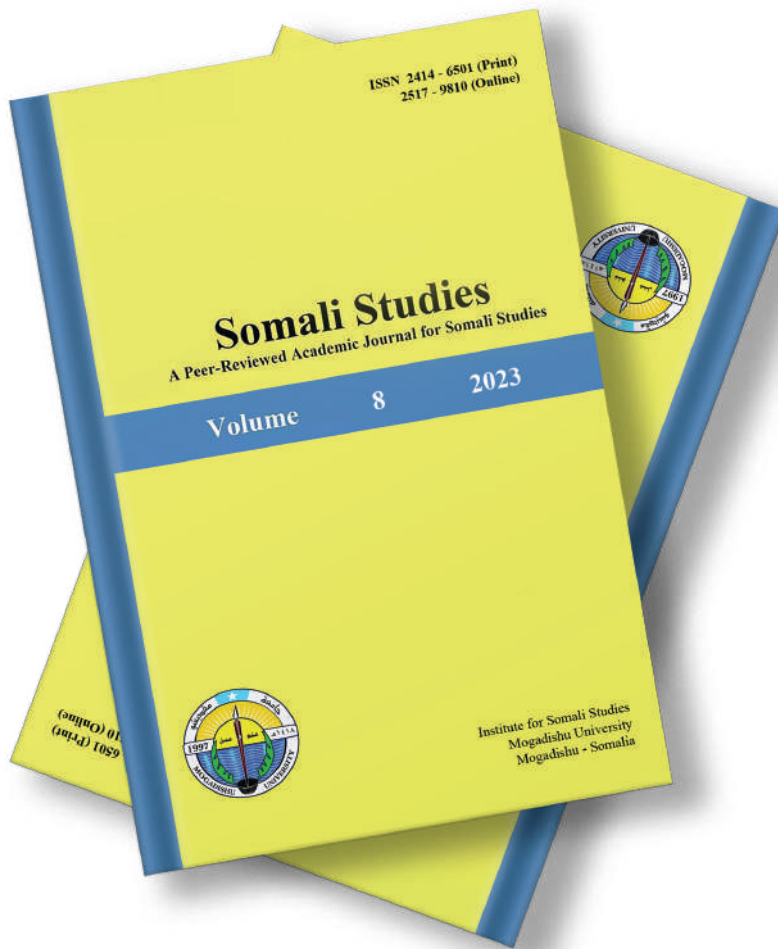
